Coppell Greens Committee Descriptions

Architectural Control Committee (ACC)

Current members: Bo Jackson, Ed Enriquez, Sharad Patel, Phil LaBerge

Duties:

- To review ACC requests that are submitted by homeowners. The requests are received by Associa and uploaded into their SmartWeb system. Committee members are then notified and can review, comment on, and vote to approve, deny or request additional information on a request. Typically, the ACC receives no more than about 2 or 3 requests per month.

- The Committee will communicate with the Board and the property manager in matters related to ACC violations.

Cleanup Committee

Duties:

- Help clean up the neighborhood by picking up litter.
- While our landscape maintenance company picks up litter when they are here mowing in the spring through the fall, they are not here during the winter. It is up to us to pick up trash during the times they are not here.
- Work with other committees to get the word out about picking up litter.
- Organize a Coppell Greens Earth Day.

Crime Watch Committee

Duties:

- Maintain the security cameras at the front entrances.
- If there is a crime, pull the SD cards in the cameras and give them to the police department.
- Help educate our homeowners about crime prevention.
- Interface with the police department.
- Consider what steps the HOA should take to help prevent crime.

Engineering Committee

Duties:

- Review and make important decisions regarding engineering related issues and respond to critical problems or events such as:
 - Denton Tap wall maintenance and repairs
 - Millsap stone retaining walls maintenance and repairs
 - Fountain maintenance and dredging the pond.
 - Interfacing with the City of Coppell Engineering Department.
- Examples of engineering issues include:
 - Dealing with flooding caused by construction of the M/I Homes project to our north.
 - Hire a civil engineer, interface with the City, and manage the modifications the north spillway.
 - Periodically replacing the bulbs at the monument sign lights and the two street lights that we installed.
 - Represent the Coppell Greens HOA at City P&Z meetings and other meetings that impact the HOA.

Landscape Committee

Duties:

- The landscape committee interfaces with our landscape maintenance company regarding repairs to
 - o the sprinkler system,
 - weed control,
 - o flower beds,
 - tree trimming, and
 - special landscape projects.
- The Committee will become familiar with our sprinkler system and be capable of shutting off a zone in case of a water leak or other issue.
- The Committee will award the Yard of the Month prize and present it to the homeowner.
- The Committee will make periodic walks through the neighborhood to check on the state of the landscaping and address any issues.
- The Committee will discuss and propose to the Board landscape projects like:
 - Planting wildflowers in the spillway;
 - Purchase and installation of more park benches;
 - Creating wild flower areas in the greenbelts.
 - Installing paths through the greenbelts.
