## **March Annual Meeting**



The annual meeting is scheduled for March 25th at 7:00pm (6:30 sign-in) at the Vista Ridge United Methodist Church across the street. This is our primary meeting of the year where we discuss the HOA's finances and hold board elections. Please make an effort to attend or send in your proxy with a neighbor. Only

homeowners in good standing are allowed to vote—please get up to date on any delinquencies before the meeting! We offered four meetings to the HOA in 2007 in order to provide as much information and communication as possible about some of the improvements to our neighborhood. We do not have any large foreseeable projects on the horizon for 2008, so we will be offering three meetings this year, instead of four. We encourage homeowners to attend all three in order to be informed, share ideas, and socialize with neighbors in Coppell Greens.

#### **Final Dues Reduction**

The latest dues reduction will be going into effect the second quarter, which begins in April. According to the reserve study we had done by an outside source, our homeowners dues have been over estimated and could be lowered. The dues will be lowered another \$15.00 a quarter-bringing our total for monthly dues to \$50 a month. You will see this reflected in your February mailing. Bringing the dues to this level allows the HOA to cover all operating expenses while still saving a moderate amount every year for repairs and maintenance. This also brings Coppell Greens closer to being more in line with what other HOA's in the area are paying in dues. The board will continue to review the possibility of lowering the dues a third and final time.

### **Board Positions**

There are two board positions up for election this year. ## Playground Issue

There will not be another vote on the playground issue this year. The vote was held in November and although the majority voted in favor of the installation of a playground, the board later learned that enough homeowners were not represented at the meeting and the vote therefore did not meet the requirement of 66% of the homeowners being in favor of it. Since such a strong interest was expressed, the issue will be addressed and possibly put for another vote next year. Please attend the annual meeting to learn further details about this issue.
