The City has been in the process of replacing sidewalks in Coppell Greens and raising utility manholes.

Development Updates

Feathers Smash: To the west of Lairds, plans have been approved and work is to start soon. Opening probably in the late summer or fall. SRINI Office & Retail Project. To the south of Mullrany. Plans are in progress. The Board has met with the developer. Probably opening in late fall or winter.

Hat Creek Burgers: To our south between Rosa's and LA Fitness. Under construction and opening soon.

Projects

Denton Tap Wall: In December, a couple of panels and columns at the Fallkirk entrance were rebuilt and cracks along the wall repaired. Cost ~ \$7k

Concrete Flume: a 300' x 2' wide concrete drainage flume was installed in the greenbelt behind 106 to 114 Turnberry to fix drainage problems. Drainage pipes and inlets were placed along the 12' tall millsap stone wall to prevent further movement. Cost ~ \$12k

New Security Cameras

Last year the Coppell Police Department gave a presentation about a new security system that reads license plates. If a plate is read that is on their hot list, it will send a notice to the police cars that are on patrol. The Board approved purchase of the system and is in the process of having it installed. As compared to the cameras that we currently have that just record plates to an SD card and are only of use after an incident occurs, the new system is real-time and will help catch criminals in the act. It will provide a much better level of security. Cost: the 4 camera system cost \$8k and there is an annual \$3k system cost.

2020 Census

In mid-March, you should receive an invitation to complete the 2020 Census. It is tremendously important that you do so. Why is it important?

- The 2020 Census will determine congressional representation, impact hundreds of billions in federal funding, and provide data that will affect communities for the next decade.
- School lunches. Plans for highways. Support for firefighters and families in need. Census results affect your community every day.

Tips

- Consider installing a smart irrigation controller. It can save you a lot of money in water costs and is good for the environment. A popular one is Rachio and costs \$218 on Amazon. There are many others.
- By far, your largest utility cost is for your electricity and your A/C system is the biggest user. If you need to replace your system, consider a high SEER system with a two stage compressor. It can have a significant impact on your bill.
- Monitor your water usage. See: <u>http://www.coppelltx.gov/h2o</u> It monitors how much you use and can send you an e-mail alert if you have a water leak.
- Monitor your electrical usage: As of January, CoServ assigned new account numbers. You will need that to access their SmartHub to monitor your electrical usage. See <u>www.coserv.com</u>
