Dead Bushes & Trees

During the big freeze in February, many plants and trees died. If your bushes or trees have not come back to life by now, they may need to be either severely cut back to allow for regrowth, or removed. If you have questions, we suggest that you consult with an arborist. Here are some examples. Figure A shows a tree where all of the branches are dead. Figure B is a tree that had all of its major branches cut back last year and has regrown since. Figure C is a tree that was cut down; however, it was not cut to the ground and the stump was not ground up so that a new tree could be planted. Figure D is a line of bushes with dead branches. Figure E is an Indian Hawthorne with leaves and branches that are dead. Figure F is an Indian Hawthorn that was cut to the ground and has started to regrow.

When the weather cools in the fall, it will be a great time to trim back or replant. The Board will review the issue later in the fall and may ask SpectrumAM to start sending out notices if no action is taken.
